In 2018, the editors reviewed 113 articles and research notes, of which 17 were submitted for the Young Author’s Prize, and 96 others.

The number of articles submitted (other than for the Young Author’s Prize) fell slightly from 2017 to 2018, following a steady rise since 2013, and the acceptance rate was nearly halved (from 23.1% in 2017 to 12.5%). This particularly affected English-language articles (acceptance rate 5.8%), most of which are rejected before reaching the reading committee, because of low quality and/or inappropriate form (report extracts, etc.).

Young Author’s Prize 2018: 17 articles were submitted and a short list of 6 examined by the panel. Of the shortlisted articles, 4 were in English and 2 in French. The 2018 prize was awarded to Marine Haddad for her article “Migration from French Overseas Departments to Metropolitan France: What We Can Learn about a State Policy from the Censuses, 1962–1999”, published in Volume 2018-2.

## Publications

In 2018, the journal published 8 volumes, 4 in French and 4 in English (4-2017, 1-2018, 2-2018, 3-2018). Total pagination was 1,564, of which 794 pages in French and 770 in English.

The journal published 18 articles and 3 research notes in each language. Six of these were uploaded to open access sites at the time of publication, including the Young Author's Prize-winning article and the overview on "Abortion Around the World".

Book reviews are published in both French and English, and are open access. Twenty-two book reviews were published in 2018.

Fertility: contribution of foreign women to period fertility in Greece (Bagavos et al.).

Sexuality: religion and sexuality in France from the 1970s to the 2000s (Maudet)

Mortality: socio-economic vulnerability and excess mortality among young adults in Switzerland (Remund)

Economic demography: employment and birth of second child in Europe (Greulich et al.); vocational choices and male–female wage gaps (Bensidoun and Trancart)

Marriage: impact of children on stability of unions in Europe (Zilincikova)

Religion and sexuality in France from the 1970s to the 2000s (Maudet)

Ageing: helping a dependent elderly relative in France (Roquebert et al.).

Residential integration of immigrants in France (McAvay)

Gender: sex imbalance at birth in Vietnam (Becquet and Guilmoto)

Methodology: acceptability of providing identifying information in transversal general population surveys (Legleye et al.); fertility indices in Spain, 1898–1970 (Devolder)

Book reviews are fully open access in both languages.
