## Early-Career Researcher Prize

The *Population* 2021 Early-Career Researcher Prize is open to students and early-career researchers working in the field of population studies and will be awarded to the most outstanding original paper submitted to the competition jury.

### Who is eligible?

- Students enrolled in PhD or Master's programmes
- Researchers who have defended their PhD thesis in the last 7 years

### What papers are eligible?

- Papers written under the researcher's own name
- Papers co-authored by two or more early-career researchers
- Papers that comply with the journal's editorial guidelines (<http://www.journal-population.com/>)
- Papers written in English or in French

### What are the key dates?

- The paper must be submitted on or before **5 November 2020**, accompanied by proof of enrolment in a Master's or PhD programme, or of PhD completion.
- Shortlist selection: December 2020.
- Results will be announced on **26 February 2021**.

### What is the prize?

- Accelerated publication
- Immediate online open access to the newly published article
- 1,000 euros (to be shared if there are several co-authors)
- One-year free subscription to *Population*
- Invitation to Paris to present the winning article at the 'Lundis de L'Ined' seminar
