

POPULATION Early-Career Researcher Prize

The Population 2023 Early-Career Researcher Prize is open to students and early-career researchers working in the field of population studies and will be awarded to the most outstanding original paper submitted to the competition jury.

Who is eligible?

- Students enrolled in PhD or Master's programmes
- Researchers who have defended their PhD thesis in the last 7 years

What papers are eligible?

- Papers written by one or several early carreer researchers
- Papers written in English or in French
- Papers that comply with the journal's editorial guidelines (http://www.journal-population.com/submission-guidelines)

What are the key dates?

- The paper must be submitted on or before **4** November 2022, accompanied by proof of enrolment in a Master's or PhD programme, or of PhD completion
- Shortlist selection: December 2022
- Results announced to candidates: early March 2023

What is the prize?

- Accelerated publication
- 1,000 euros (to be shared if there are several co-authors)
- Invitation to Paris to present the winning article at the 'Lundis de l'Ined' seminar
